Parent Information regarding UKS2 SATs 2024

Dear Y6 Parents,

This term, on the week beginning Monday 13th May, Statutory Testing (SATs) will begin for pupils in Y6.

The children have all worked extremely hard this year and are well-prepared for these tests. Some anxiety or nerves is normal, but please reassure your child that doing their best is all that counts! If you have any concerns, please contact your child's class teacher via Class Dojo.

All tests are held during the school day, within the school building. Children will be split into different classroom / work spaces to complete the different tests. The children will complete six different tests: Grammar, Spelling, Reading, Maths Arithmetic and two Maths Reasoning.

We follow the scheduled timetable prepared by the DfE:

All Y6 children will participate in SATS, unless you have been informed otherwise by the school.

Testing is in the morning. The children will then continue with their normal school days. Uniform or PE kit (day dependent) should be worn as usual - please see information on Class Dojo for regular PE days. Children do not require any equipment as school will provide everything they will need to use.

It is very important that all children arrive to school punctually: in order to further support Y6, school will be offering a free breakfast club place to all children taking SATs on the **four testing days**. This does not need to be booked. We will be offering breakfast to all children in Y6 from 8am until 8.30am Monday 13th - Thursday 16th May. Unfortunately, we cannot offer space for siblings - this must be booked through the normal pathway.
