You can now enrol your child in Stockport's free summer activity programme, and give them a summer filled with fun activities and great food.

Provided as part of the government's Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme being delivered across Stockport, there are **FREE** places on the programme available for children and young people who receive means-tested free school meals.

Your child will be able to access up to 16 sessions that are 4 hours long, with some clubs offering longer sessions. This includes specific provision for children with SEND or additional needs – and all at no cost to you. The sessions will include a variety of fun activities, including sports, music, arts and other exciting opportunities to learn and develop skills, alongside a nutritious meal each day.
