
What is Google Classroom?

Your child was provided with a secure login and password that is unique to them. This is stuck in their reading diary for reference.




Open the internet and type in classroom.google.com



Click on


Go to Classroom






Type in your child's email address and password to sign in.


If you get stuck, you can post a note to your teacher about it in the comments section.
